Team Helping Hannah runs because Hannah can't.

In April 2010, many of the team members were part of a fundraising event for a little girl by the name of Hannah Bernard. Her father, Derek is the founder of a legendary local band Derek and the Slammers. The family's life turned upside down when 14-year-old Hannah was diagnosed with Reflex Sympathetic Dystrophy, which attacks the nervous system causing chronic and debilitating pain. And, now it has attacked Hannah's eyesight.

There is no cure and the treatments to control the pain are so expensive that money is always an issue.

Team Helping Hannah is running the Central Florida Ragnar Relay - a race across the state of Florida from Port Richey to Daytona Beach - for Hannah and are raising money for every mile the team completes - 200 miles.

We call it **Small Change for a Big Change** since we are only asking people to reach into their change jars and pledge a nickel, dime, or quarter per mile. The economy is tough for everyone but even \$10 (nickel a mile) can make a difference in the life of a little girl.
